

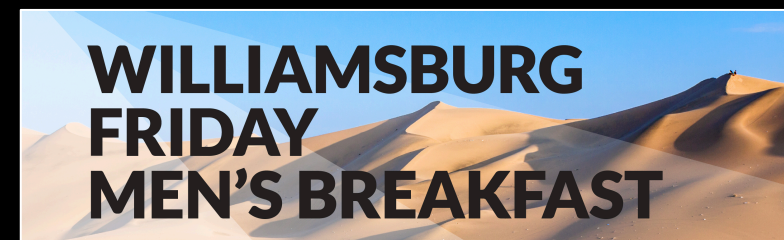

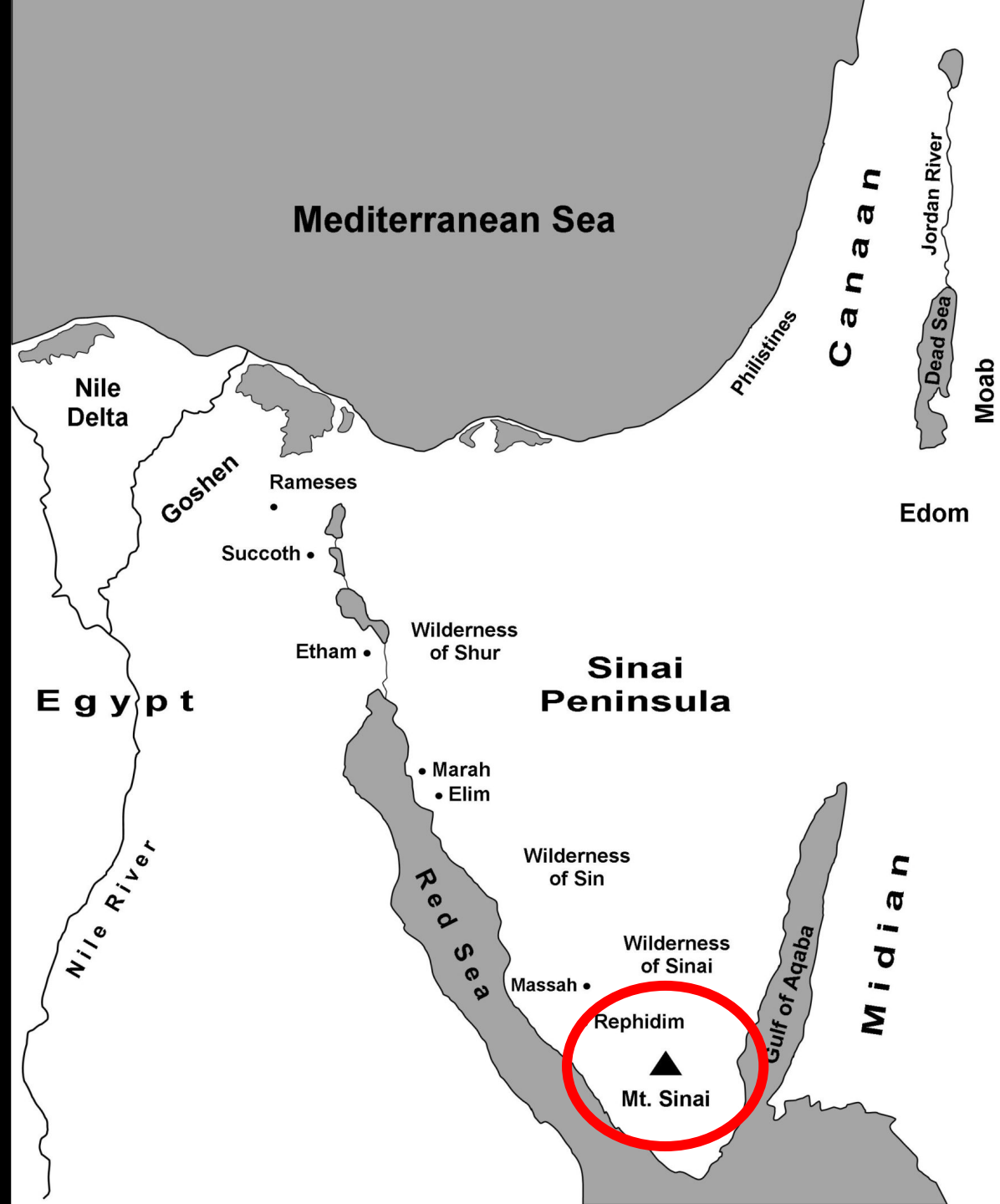
**#6 – What do the 10 Commandments

## Exodus 19:20–21

<sup>20</sup> And Yahweh went down on Mount Sinai, to the top of the mountain, and Yahweh called Moses to the top of the mountain, and Moses went up.

<sup>21</sup> And Yahweh said to Moses, “Go down, warn the people, lest they break through to Yahweh to see and many from them fall.”



## Exodus 3:12

“But I will be with you, and this shall be the sign for you, that I have sent you: when you have brought the people out of Egypt, you shall serve God on this mountain.”

# Framework & Flow of the Biblical Law

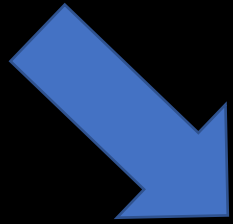
2 Main (Greatest) Commandments from which all other commandments flow:

- “Love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength” – Deuteronomy 6:5
- “Love your neighbor as yourself” – Leviticus 19:18b

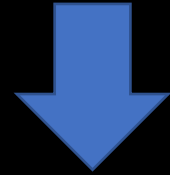

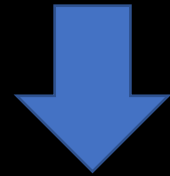

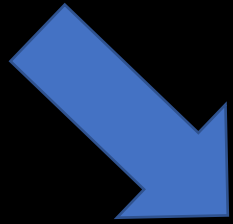

# The First Command – Hierarchy or Exclusivity?

“You shall have no other gods before me” –  
Exodus 22:3

Exclusivity!  
No other gods besides Me!



## The Second Command – Relational or Transactional?

Biblical faith is relational.

YHWH wants to love and be loved.

Idolatry is transactional.

Idols want to be fed and carried around.

## The Third Command – Profane Language or Something More?

We break the 3<sup>rd</sup> commandment any time we devalue the worthiness of the name **LORD** and the God it represents.

## The Fourth Command – A Day off ... A Church day?

The Sabbath was not a day to stop work without worshipping the Lord ... nor was it a day to worship the Lord without stopping work.

# Jesus and the Commandments

Jesus said, “Do not think that I have come to abolish the Law or the Prophets; I have not come to abolish them but to fulfill them” – Matthew 5:17



# Jesus and the Commandments

Command 2 – Jesus was the ultimate physical representation of God ... not formed by humans

Command 3 – Jesus taught His followers to pray, “Father ... hallowed be thy name” and He asked, “Why do you call me ‘LORD, LORD’ and do not do why I say?”

# Jesus and the Commandments

Command 4 – In Matt 12, Jesus is accused of breaking the sabbath by healing someone. Jesus explains His opponent's misunderstanding of the sabbath and declare Himself LORD of the Sabbath.

# Jesus and the Commandments

Command 5 – Jesus rebukes religious leaders in Matt 15 for using their religion as a loophole to not honor their parents.

# Jesus and the Commandments

Command 6 – Jesus talks about being angry with another human being and calling them a name as murdering them in your heart.



# Jesus and the Commandments

Command 7 – Jesus' teaching on adultery goes beyond the physical act to include lust in the heart as adulterous.

# Jesus and the Commandments

Command 8 – Jesus reinforces the command to not steal in Matt, Mark, & Luke

# Jesus and the Commandments


Command 9 – In Matt 15:19, Jesus says that bearing false witness originates in the heart.

Command 10 – Jesus warns against coveting in Luke 12:15.


