



### Celebration

### What is a celebration?

To celebrate means to do something special for an important event, occasion, or to observe a holiday or important occasion in some special way or to perform a religious ceremony.

#### Numbers 9:1-5 (NIV)

•9 The LORD spoke to Moses in the Desert of Sinai in the first month of the second year after they came out of Egypt. He said, <sup>2</sup> "Have the Israelites celebrate the Passover at the appointed time. <sup>3</sup> Celebrate it at the appointed time, at twilight on the fourteenth day of this month, in accordance with all its rules and regulations."

### Numbers 9:1-5 (NIV)

<sup>4</sup> So Moses told the Israelites to celebrate the Passover, <sup>5</sup> and they did so in the Desert of Sinai at twilight on the fourteenth day of the first month. The Israelites did everything just as the LORD commanded Moses.



# What is obedience?

### Obedience

•Obedience is the compliance with an order, request, or law or submission to another's authority.

<sup>15</sup> On the day the tabernacle, the tent of the covenant law, was set up, the cloud covered it. From evening till morning the cloud above the tabernacle looked like fire. <sup>16</sup> That is how it continued to be; the cloud covered it, and at night it looked like fire.

•<sup>17</sup> Whenever the cloud lifted from above the tent, the Israelites set out; wherever the cloud settled, the Israelites encamped. <sup>18</sup> At the LORD's command the Israelites set out, and at his command they encamped. As long as the cloud stayed over the tabernacle, they remained in camp.

<sup>19</sup> When the cloud remained over the tabernacle a long time, the Israelites obeyed the LORD's order and did not set out. <sup>20</sup> Sometimes the cloud was over the tabernacle only a few days; at the LORD's command they would encamp, and then at his command they would set out.

<sup>21</sup> Sometimes the cloud stayed only from evening till morning, and when it lifted in the morning, they set out. Whether by day or by night, whenever the cloud lifted, they set out. <sup>22</sup> Whether the cloud stayed over the tabernacle for two days or a month or a year, the Israelites would remain in camp...

...and not set out; but when it lifted, they would set out. <sup>23</sup> At the LORD's command they encamped, and at the LORD's command they set out. They obeyed the LORD's order, in accordance with his command through Moses.

# Numbers 10:11-15 (NIV)

<sup>11</sup> On the twentieth day of the second month of the second year, the cloud lifted from above the tabernacle of the covenant law. <sup>12</sup> Then the Israelites set out from the Desert of Sinai and traveled from place to place until the cloud came to rest in the Desert of Paran.

# Numbers 10:11-15 (NIV)

<sup>13</sup> They set out, this first time, at the LORD's command through Moses. <sup>14</sup> The divisions of the camp of Judah went first, under their standard. Nahshon son of Amminadab was in command. <sup>15</sup> Nethanel son of Zuar was over the division of the tribe of Issachar...
