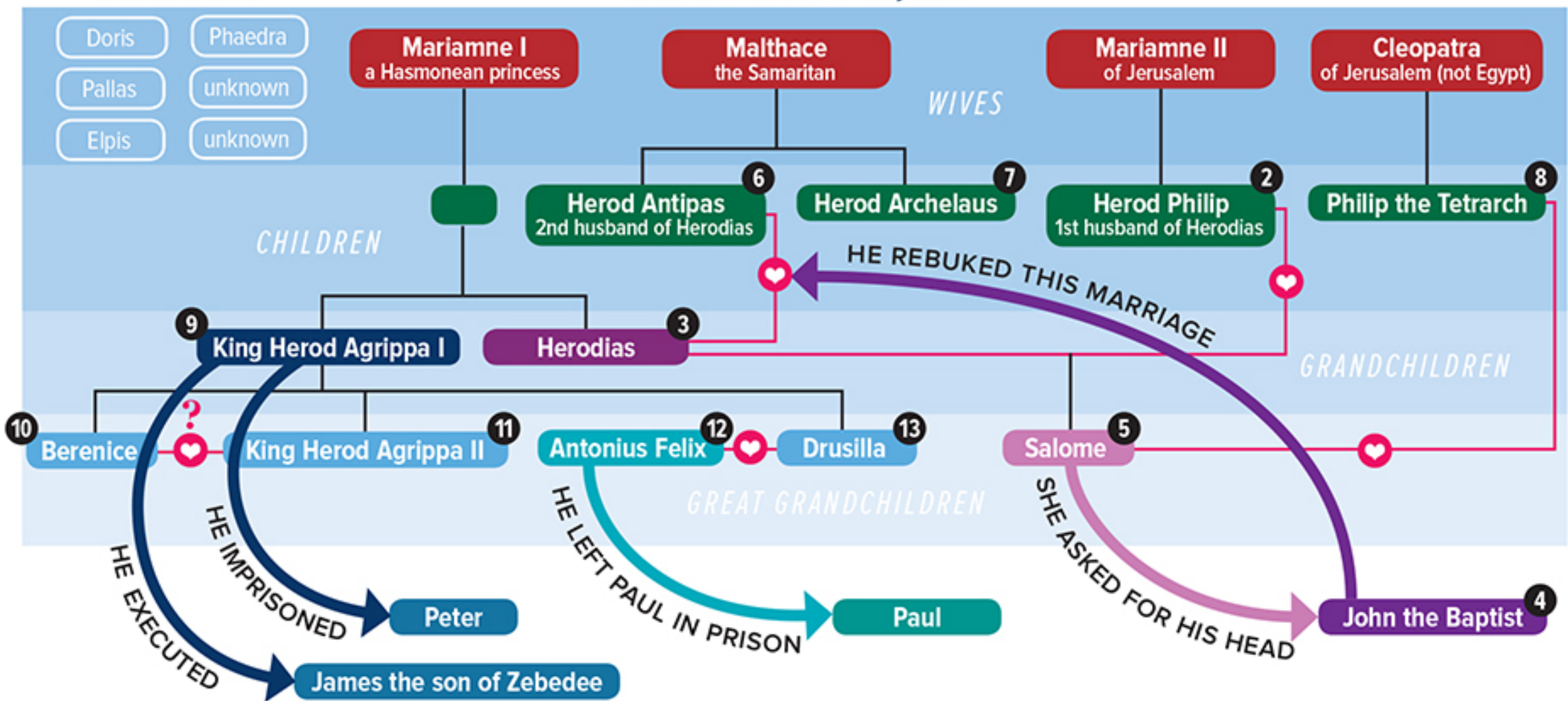

# Leviticus 18:16

“You shall not uncover the nakedness of your brother’s wife; it is your brother’s nakedness.”

# Leviticus 20:21

“If a man takes his brother’s wife, it is impurity. He has uncovered his brother’s nakedness; they shall be childless.”

## 4 Contributing Factors to Herod's Having John Killed

- Alcohol
- Looking to a seductive woman for entertainment and titillation
- An oversized desire to impress others.
- A influential spouse pushing him away from God rather than toward Him.

# Matthew 11:2–3

“Now when John heard in prison about the deeds of the Christ, he sent word by his disciples and said to him, ‘Are you the one who is to come, or shall we look for another?’”



# Matthew 11:10–11

Jesus said John the Baptist is the "Elijah who is to come" and, "No one born of women has been greater than John the Baptist."

# Mark 8:27–30

Jesus asks two questions:

- “Who do the people say that I am?”
- “Who do you say that I am?”
