3. Percentage of attendance serving: Serving involves making sacrifices that develop connections with others and provide opportunities for growth.

- Fulfill the duties of membership as described in the Chapel Constitution
- Members best fulfill the duties of membership through involvement in a Chapel group and through serving

Attendance:

- Sunday corporate worship experiences

Group:

- Meets regularly
- Reads the Bible together
- Prays together
- Cares for each other and the community
- Encourages corporate worship
- Is lead by a Chapel Leader

Service:

- Everyone who serves at the Chapel or with a Chapel partner deserves a job description
- When emphasizing the call to service we recognize that this occurs by serving at the Chapel, with Chapel partners, and through personal efforts to partner with Jesus in the building of His kingdom wherever He calls.
