Small Group Questions | April 29th, 2018

Kingdom Mission - Witness (1 Peter 2:9-12)

Sermon Recap: Peter calls us, the Church, to **get our identity right** and **live out our identity rightly.** Through Christ, we are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a Holy nation, God's special possession, and recipients of Mercy. We can abstain from the flesh and maintain honorable conduct for the praises of His glory.

Hook: These questions can help encourage conversation.

1. What does the world say about our identity? How was it formed?

Look: Read the sermon passage. Answer the following textual questions.

- 2. What are the five truths of our identity as listed in 1 Peter 2:9-10?
- 3. How does Exodus 19:5-6 help us to understand Peter's call for the Church to live out its identity?
- 4. Read Matthew 5:16, in light of Peter's call, what is the goal behind living the way God has proclaimed?
- 5. Reading 1 Peter 2:11-12, What does Peter challenge us to abstain from and what does he challenge us to maintain?

Took: Applying the message to our lives.

- 6. What are you challenged to root your identity in other than Jesus? How do we combat those desires?
- 7. How would you like to live out your identity in Christ more 'rightly' before others? How can this group help you do that?
